1. Required Qualifications & Experience

- HND in IT or higher qualification from a recognized institution.
- Minimum 5 year experience in the IT industry in software or related roles which
 include native mobile application and java client and server development
 experience.
- Demonstrable experience in Model Driven Development using java. MDD
 Experience in native android is preferable.
- Prior experience in the following technologies and tools
 - SQLite database, MySQL database. Database synchronization solutions
 - Android native UI development
 - Java based Business Process Management (BPM) systems or workflow

engines.

- · Rest architecture
- Java Servlet, JPA, JPQL, Hibernate, Tomcat application server
- Light weight Linux desktop environments and command line
- Netbeans, VS Code, Android Studio, My SQL workbench

3. Method of Appointment

- All submitted proposals will be evaluated by the TEC approved by the Vice-Chancellor to select a suitable FSFD to carry out the task.
- The assignment will be valid for a six (06) month contract period. The contract may be renewed based on satisfactory performance and the requirement.
- The agreement may be modified with the written consent of both parties during the period.

4. Scope of the Activity

The research project AI Enabled Systems and Methods for Retail Sector is an attempt to address the problems faced by the local retailers through AI, software and hardware optimization and usability research. Research team has implemented a mobile phone application prototype using java based workflow engine as a backend. The FSFD needs to work closely with the research team in order to extend the functionalities of this client server mobile application. The FSFD is expected initiate the work using the existing code base as a starting point.

5. Remuneration

Payments will be made upon completion of each mile stone and submission of the activity report with the recommendation of the Principal Investigator (PI).

6. Reporting Obligations

The selected FSFD will report to the PI. The FSFD is should be available at least one day onsite per week during the period of the contract.
