(iii) Equivalent qualification from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University with prior learning/ work experience in the field of Conflict & Peace Studies; or

(iv) Completion of NVQ level 7 (equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in Conflict & Peace Studies as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University of Colombo And

A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and/or selection interview.

Each application under clause (iv) shall be considered on its merit.

The Faculty is drawn from professional and academics who are actively engaged in the field of conflict resolution in Sri Lanka.

The Teaching will be mainly based on application and the case-study approach, in addition to other modern methods.
